Joint Board Resolution No.2013-10

Beach Guidelines and Responsibilities

This resolution governs the responsibilities of Greenbank Beach and Boat Club and individual property owners in managing and using the GBBC facilities both land based and tidal areas.

Each member, as defined in by-laws and in good standing, is issued one key to the beach gate. It is the responsibility of each key holder to protect their key and not loan, duplicate or otherwise allow non-property owners to gain unescorted access to beach facilities.

Use of beach facilities, including launch ramp, picnic area, beach front and tidal waters is the responsibility of the GBBC Board of Trustees. No overnight storage of boats, vehicles, trailers or other personal property is allowed on GBBC beach front and tidal water property. No personal buoys are allowed on GBBC property or tidelands at anytime. DNR Regulations state a request to place such a buoy must be first given by GBBC Board and the various permits issued by the required government agencies. All unauthorized buoys are considered trespassing.
